May 28, 1913 - November 14, 2007

Daniel Garza Aguirre passed away on November 14, 2007, at the age of 94. He was born on May 28, 1913 in San Antonio, Texas to Roman and Adela Aguirre. He is survived by his four children, Daniel Michael Aguirre, Guadalupe Oscar Aguirre, Norma Rose Baird and Diane Silva Coward; nine grandchildren: Michael Alan Aguirre, Keith Daniel Aguirre, Nicole Desiree Aguirre, Gabrielle Estelle Rosas, April Suzanne Nett, Matt Louis Aguirre, Catherine Rose Cisneros, Monica Joy Dooley and Jeremy Patrick Coward; 12 great grandchildren, plus a great granddaughter due to arrive on February 4th, 2008, which would have been his wife's 89th birthday. Mrs. Zenobia Silva Aguirre preceded her husband in passing on July 24th, 2004, at the age of 85. Mr. Aguirre was in the U.S. Army from 1943 to 1946, serving in China, India and what was then known as Burma. While in military service, he earned an Asiatic-Pacific Campaign Medal, a Good Conduct Medal, a Victory Ribbon and an Overseas Service Ribbon. Mr. Aguirre worked hard from his childhood days until he could no longer physically do so. He was an upholsterer by trade, and after retiring from civil service at Fort Sam Houston, he spent many hours continuing to upholster furniture for friends and family, working in the yard, planting tomatoes, growing flowers, and also tinkering in his garage. Mr. Aguirre believed in a loving and merciful God the Father, with whom he had a relationship by accepting the Son of God, Jesus Christ, as his personal savior: He desired the same for all of his children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren.
