Danny Ellis, age 60, ran into the arms of Jesus, Saturday, January 23, 2021. His life celebration will be held at 3 p.m., Saturday, January 30, at Mission Park Funeral Chapel North, 3401 Cherry Ridge, San Antonio, with visitation occurring from 2 p.m.– 3 p.m. Interment will follow at Mission Burial Park North.

Danny Ellis was born December 12, 1960 in San Antonio, Texas to parents David Ellis and Karen Rock Ellis. Danny worked at USAA since 1984, currently serving as an IT Director in the Enterprise Content Management organization. He received his degree from Howard Payne University and his MBA from Our Lady of the Lake University. Danny was an avid fisherman, loved baseball, and enjoyed playing the guitar and singing, often leading praise and worship. However, Danny's greatest joy was supporting and loving his sons and caring deeply for his family.
