The family moved to San Antonio in the 60’s where Mike enjoyed playing as a Junior Golfer at Oak Hills Country Club. Mike attended Alamo Heights High School and played on the State Championship Golf Team. In the summer of 1965, Mike was crowned the City Junior Golf Champion at Brackenridge Park Golf Course.

Mike enjoyed playing on the Odessa Junior College Golf Team his freshman year and then transferring to The University of Texas Golf Team to continue his collegiate golf. When Fair Oaks Ranch opened, built and designed by Gary Player, Mike became its first head golf professional. Mike later returned to Oak Hills as the head teaching professional. For the last 10 years, Mike has owned and operated the Northeast Golf Center in San Antonio where he leaves behind his beloved cat “Chase” and also in remembrance of “Ceaser” his Great Dane who greeted all who came to practice.

Mike is preceded in death by his mother and father, Dorothy and Dutch Bowersock. Survivors include his brother, Douglas Craig Bowersock and wife Sherry and son, Justin and wife Ashley Bowersock; nephew, Davis and

nieces, Kamie and Hallie Bowersock, all of Spring, TX
