



David A. (Tony) Brantley

October 25, 1929 - January 20, 2017

David Anthony (Tony) Brantley entered into eternal rest on January 20, 2017 at the age of 87. Tony was a native of Florida and moved to San Antonio in 1949, drafted by the USAF at Lackland AFB during the Korean War. While serving at Lackland, Tony met his loving wife of 60 years, Annedelle, at Travis Park UMC, where she worked.

Tony was awarded an Honorable Discharge from the Air Force in 1953 under a special program to attend Seminary. He attended Perkins School of Theology at SMU in Dallas. The Reverend Tony Brantley served several churches for the next 25 years in the Southwest Texas Methodist Conference in San Antonio, San Angelo, and Weslaco.

Tony and Annedelle had 4 children, which were the core of their lives. They loved to travel, and spent many years of their retirement traveling all over the world. Tony was very active in the Northside Lions Club in San Antonio for almost 40 years. He held several offices in the Lions Club and was passionate about recruiting new members for the Club.

Tony was predeceased by his wife, Annedelle, last year. He is survived by his children, Laura (Carl), Guy (Sarah), Mary, Bonnie (Joe), and by his grandchildren, Cristina (Chris), Alyssa (JC), and D'Shea (Gabe), Brian, and Casey, two great-grandchildren, Jace and Liam (as well as Lucy due in

February).
