Memories of you are too deep to forget you my brother. I couldn't forget you if tired.

Bruce and Diana always made me feel welcomed, even taking me to church a time or two on Sundays because I had spent the night. I remember Diana always correcting David to keep him in line, and Bruce being a solid supporter of his boy.
