David Allen Carle, age 76, of San Antonio, passed away peacefully, at his home, on January 19, 2023. David was born on April 25, 1946, in Dodge City, Kansas, to the late Clemence Alfred and Florence Margaret Warren Carle. Following high school, David joined the United States Navy where he saw combat during the Vietnam Conflict.

David married the love of his life, and his best friend, Marlys Ann Wild, in July 1978. Together they would share nearly 30 years of love and laughter and a lifetime of memories. She preceded him in death in July 2007.

David went to school at St. Gerard's Catholic School. The lesson's he learned there carried with him throughout his life. David was a quiet man who rarely talked about his service and the combat he saw in Vietnam, but he was proud to be a veteran and the time he served. Upon returning to civilian life, he took up a career as a diesel mechanic where he worked for many years. As the years began to catch up to him, David transitioned into working as a courier driver.

Those who knew David best will remember a man who was quiet; until you got him talking. He had a hard exterior and was never shy of telling another man how he felt about him but to his beloved family he made sure they knew he loved them. Love to David meant to "get up, go to work, and provide for

family". In his free time, David enjoyed tinkering with muscle cars and stringing fishing lines. David was a fighter. Though cancer took a toll on his body, David never let it get him down. His life of dedication to his work and his family, his fighting spirit to stand up for his country and to fight cancer head on, and his sense of humor towards life will live on the hearts of those he knew and loved.

David is survived by one daughter, Theresa Renee Salinas, and husband Jimmy; one son, Daryl Carle, and wife Katie; grandchildren, Brooke Carle, Taylor Shiroky, Connor Shiroky, Riley Carle; two sisters, Elaine Perkins, and husband Al, and Donna Cervenka, and husband Clyde; and by a host of nieces, nephews and other relatives and friends.
