David C. Duque of San Antonio, Texas went to be with the Lord on July 26, 2020 at the age of 93. He is preceded in death by his parents Sabas and Antonia Duque; daughter, Rachel Duque and son, Carlos Duque. Survivors include his wife of 66 years, Angelita P. Duque, his loving children Col (Ret) David Duque, Jr., Oscar O. Duque and Rosario P. Duque-Chavez; 3 grandchildren, Stephanie M. Duque-Vazques, Charles A. Duque and Jesus Alejandro (Alex) Chavez; 1 great grandchild, Sabastian Zubia and other family members and friends.

David was born in Goliad, TX on December 29, 1926. His father moved the family down to the Rio Grande Valley when David was still young. He was drafted in WW2 and was about to get shipped to the Pacific front when the atomic bombs were dropped on Japan. After the war ended, David went back to Texas and continued to travel across the US as a migrant farm worker. He married Angelita Perez March 8, 1954. They settled in San Antonio, TX where he lived most of his life. He retired from the US Postal Service after 30 years of service.
