David Merrell, loving husband, father, and grandfather died Monday, September 13, 2010, after a brief illness. He was born in 1949 in San Antonio, TX. He is preceded in death by his parents, Paul and Mildred Merrell and brothers Richard and Kenneth Merrell. He is survived by his wife of forty years, Margo; son Patrick and his wife Sara; daughter Lisa and her husband Richard Evans, and their daughter Allison. He is also survived by his older brother, Paul and wife, Carol; sisters-in-law, Carolyn and Elsie; and numerous nieces & nephews. David graduated from McCollum High School and attended San Antonio College, where he met Margo during the second week of school. David and Margo transferred to the University of Texas at Austin, where David graduated with a degree in Education in History and Government. He then began a thirty-one year teaching career at Lackland later Stacey High School in San Antonio. He later earned a Masters in History from the University of Texas at San Antonio. David was a passionate teacher, encouraging his students to be involved in the school and community by sponsoring organizations like the Humanities Club and the class of 1997. He later developed and sponsored a nationally recognized Vietnam Project, where students performed original research for fallen soldiers from San Antonio. In retirement, David became an avid gardener, earning the designation of Master Gardener. An enthusiastic Democrat, David actively campaigned for President Obama as a precinct captain during the 2008 election. He enjoyed spending time with his children and granddaughter, and taking his wife on dates. David's

memory will live on and inspire all those who knew him. A memorial service will be held on Friday, September 17 at 2:00 PM at Covenant Presbyterian Church, 211 Roletto Dr, San Antonio, TX 78213.
