David Frederick Wagner Born 9-5-29 in Elizabeth City, NJ, passed 11-17-08 peacefully in his home in San Antonio, TX. He was preceded in death by his first wife Elaine and his sister Alma, and is survived by his "darlin" wife Gerry, daughter Sherry and her husband Louis Correa and their children Tess, Andrew and Kyle, son Eric and his wife Missy and their son Brandon, son Jeff and his wife Bronwyn and their daughter Lauren, and son Jason and his fiancé Angie Guerra and her daughters Jamie and Jazmine, his sisters Edna Putz, Emma Miller, Ruth Miller and Joyce Lewis, and his mother in law Anna Clark. He served in the military from 1949 to 1952. He was honorably discharged in Ft. Bliss, TX where he started his business selling vacuum cleaners door to door. Dave moved to San Antonio, TX in 1960 where he began to finance the vacuum cleaners and that led to his passion of starting a finance business, Personal Credit Plan, Inc. in 1961. The company grew to 36 offices before he sold the company in 1995. Five years later, Dave returned to the loan business and opened 8 offices and gave the managers a chance to own their own company. Dave was very proud of his family. He took great pleasure in hearing about their accomplishments and telling anyone who would listen about their achievements. Dave lived life to the fullest. From inventing an ozone generator with his friend Tony to waking his children up in the mornings by being dressed in a straw hat and ukulele singing "Tip toe

through the tulips." Dave had a zest for living. He could talk about virtually any subject with anybody and speak intelligently. Dave was also very generous. He helped many people out of crisis not to mention helping others start their own businesses. He loved being around people and having a wine with them. Whether it was a weekend get together or a formal party, a Dave Wagner function was a Gala event. There was always lots of people around him having lots of fun. Dave is gone now but will not be forgotten. In Dave's words, remember: "The Lord loves a cheerful giver."
