Dazel Rachel (Davis) Ball, 101-years young, slipped into eternal life on January 7, 2023 in San Antonio, Texas. Dazel was born at home on August 2, 1921 in McMillan, Oklahoma to Mattie (Burns) Davis and Dave Richard Davis. Dazel completed Indian School at Bloomfield Academy, and graduated from Madill, Oklahoma High School. She attended the University of Oklahoma where she met her husband, Willis H. (Bill) Ball. After WWII, they farmed and ranched at Marlow, Oklahoma. A member of the church of Christ, she was an avid Bible student and teacher. Preceded in death by her husband, a son, Howard Grant Ball, and both parents, she is survived by two sons, Willis H. Ball (Janel), Wayne Bernard Ball, and a daughter, Lynn Rutland (Randy), plus six grandchildren and nine great grandchildren.
