Our beloved mother, most loving grandmother, Mrs. Devasitham Ezekiel, was called to be with the Lord on July 31, 2007 at the age of 88. She was born as the only daughter with 2 brothers in Kolar Gold Fields in India. After marrying the late Rev. Noah John Ezekiel she served the Lord, along with him, at Concordia Missouri Lutheran Mission in Southern India as a teacher, mother, and counselor for more than 40 years. She continued her faith and belief through her membership at Redeemer Lutheran Church in San Antonio, Texas. The late Rev. and Mrs. Ezekiel made a commitment through their mission and assisted many orphans, deaf and blind children as well as other needy youngsters in the community. She is sorely missed by her 7 children; 4 daughters and 3 sons, and their spouses; as well as 14 grandchildren; 5 granddaughters and 9 grandsons.
