Dewey G. Younger passed away on July 16, 2010. He was born on July 28, 1922 in San Antonio, TX to Marie Gibson Younger and Dewey G. Younger, Sr. He attended Brackenridge High, then received his MS in Aeronautical Engineering from UT. He worked in aerospace at Southwest Research, North American Aviation, and Aeronutronic, and later retired from Ford Motor Company. He and his wife returned to San Antonio where he was a professor at Trinity University, as well as taking over operation of Gibson's Costume Shop, founded by his grandparents in 1928.
