Diana Elizabeth Clayton, age 78, of Schertz, formerly of San Antonio, passed away peacefully in her sleep in the early morning hours of Sunday, October 16, 2022, surrounded by family. Diana was born on August 10, 1944, in San Antonio, to the late Manuel and Evangelina Ovalle Williams. Following high school, Diana went to work as a representative for USAA, then moved into a role with the company of Sears where she served as a secretary and customer service representative.
