DiAnn Escobar Herrera, a longtime City of San Antonio employee who volunteered for the United Way and the St. Vincent De Paul Society, died Tuesday, July 13, 2010, peacefully and at home. The San Antonio native, born April 12, 1948, was 62, and had battled cancer the last few months of her life. A beloved wife, daughter, sister, aunt and friend, she attended St. Joseph Catholic School and Blessed Sacrament High School. She graduated in 1966. And, attended Our Lady of the Lake University. She was preceded in death by her father, Oscar Escobar, and is survived by her devoted husband, Arthur R. Herrera; and a large family that includes her loving mother, Frances Escobar; two sisters, Raquel and Maryalice "Mae" Escobar; three brothers, Rudy, Oscar and his wife Judy, and Adolph and wife Debbie; nine nieces and nephews; 15 great nieces and nephews; and special friends, David and Nora Herrera, Damien Herrera, Natalie Herrera, Daniel and Veronica Herrera and their daughter, Amy. DiAnn was personnel director of the San Antonio Public Library for 27 years and served on many United Way committees. She played an important role in her sister's public relations business, serving as vice president of special events and working on the Fiesta campaigns of two Rey Feos and El Consejo, a group of former Rey Feos. She loved her home, gardening almost every day since her retirement. She enjoyed traveling and spending time with her husband and family. She was active in Holy Spirit

Catholic Church, where she volunteered with the St. Vincent De Paul Society.
