



## Dicksie W. Blumberg

May 27, 1915 - February 4, 2019

Dicksie Winifred Blumberg was born on May 27, 1915 and went to be with the lord on February 4, 2019. Dicksie was born in Del Rio, Texas to parents Dick and Winifred McConnell. She was affectionately referred to by many as “Del Rio Dicksie!”

Dicksie settled in San Antonio, Texas and graduated from Brackenridge High School. She was an active member of Travis Park United Methodist Church, where she met her husband Armin Walter Blumberg whom she married on August 7, 1939. The couple raised three children together and were married until his death on August 31, 1975.

Dicksie worked at the Methodist Building and the Post Office in historic La Villita until the age of eighty-eight. She served as a communion steward at Travis Park United Methodist Church and volunteered with the Harlequin Theatre. She was also an active participant in many Volks marches throughout Texas. Dicksie loved people and her lord and savior Jesus Christ. Dicksie is preceded in death by her parents Dick and Winifred McConnell; siblings Dick McConnell Jr. and Alberta Bosch; husband Armin Walter Blumberg Sr.; children Armin Blumberg Jr. and Janice Sue Farrell (Charles).
