After a lengthy illness, Donald L. Ashcraft went to be with his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, the morning of Sept 1, 2007. Born, July 3, 1933 to Philip Lamond and Kenneth Juanita Ashcraft, he married Kathleen J. Bennack on January 18, 1990. He leaves to cherish his memory: his wife, Kayte, his sister, Lynda Connor of Tulsa, one son, Steve and wife, Tricia of Whitney, 2 daughters, Donna Kay Jordan of Bandera and Sonja Word and husband Cole of Meridian. He also leaves nine grandsons, 6 great-grandchildren, 6 nieces, and numerous friends all over the world. He was preceded in death by his parents, his brother, Gene Ashcraft of Fort Worth, and his son, Mark Ashcraft of Florida.

Mr. Ashcraft was ordained as a Minister of the Gospel in the 1970's by World Ministry Fellowship. He co-founded Blessed Hope Academy in San Antonio and Boerne, and Beloved Hope Academy in Lakehills. In 1995, he and his wife joined Friendships, a world-wide disaster and relief ministry. He served in Los Angeles and Roatan, Honduras as Facilities Administrator. In 2002, he was forced to return to the states for medical treatment. A member of Faith Outreach Center International in San Antonio, he was a deacon and involved in prison ministry.
