March 27, 1929 - January 21, 2008

Doris D. Cook, age 78, peacefully entered into eternal rest on January 21, 2008 in Bloomington, Indiana. Doris was born March 27, 1929 to George and Hazel Emmons in Ottawa, Kansas.
