Never afraid of a challenge, she and George restored her parents' San Saba home in her retirement years and then returned to San Antonio to be full time caregivers for her special needs grandson. In her mid Seventies she moved to Helotes to occupy her own little 200 sf cottage. This was tiny even before they were called Tiny houses. She enjoyed independence but was always happy to have a visitor and to still travel well into her Eighties.

In 2017 at Eighty seven she became a resident at Brookdale Whitby Assisted Living in San Antonio. There she made some friends and accepted that this would be a nice place to live out her remaining years. Due to deteriorating health, she spent her final days with visits from her loving Daughters and the constant care of Francie, her Middle daughter, comforting her in her last few

days here on Earth. Doris now spreads her Angel wings and Ascends to Heaven to reunite with George and all those loving Family members who arrived before her.
