



## Doris Marie Dimas

Doris Marie Dimas was born in San Antonio, Texas on September 18, 1936. She was the daughter of Mildred and Samuel Williams. Due to her father's military obligations, she was raised by her father's brother, her most beloved uncle Ray and Aunt Ruth. Doris traveled to Greece at the age of 13 as her father was assigned to the American Embassy in Athens. Six months prior to returning to the United States she met her beloved husband of 67 years, Dimitris "Jimmy". She returned to Athens at 17 and married at 18, returned to San Antonio and have lived here ever since. Doris was not raised in the Greek Orthodox Church, but was baptized before her marriage; taking the baptismal name Dorothea. She was a devout member of St. Sophia's Greek Orthodox Church and her great pride was being the godmother (Nona) of Father Jordan Brown. She was especially grateful for the blessings bestowed on her by Father Dan, Father Jordan, and Father Thomas. Doris was a dedicated employee of Beechcraft Aviation for 37 years She had a huge place in her heart for all animals, especially dogs and especially her boxer, Athena. Doris was compassionate, caring and generous with everyone both friends and strangers every day of her life. Doris is survived by her beloved Dimitrios; daughter, Olga; son-in-law, Evangelos; 4 grandchildren, Anastasia, Dorothea, Andreas and Dimitris; 2 great-grandchildren; and by a much loved niece, Moninne.

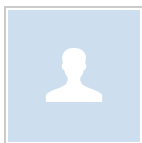
