One last thing I’ll always remember. I was 8 the evening we got the call from the hospital that my Daddy had died. Mom had to go immediately to the hospital, so where else would 4 kids ages 10, 8, 6, and 4 go? Next door to the Bauwens house. I remember being in your den, waiting for my mom to return, and how it wasn’t an unpleasant visit. I actually enjoyed the visit. Because of Dorothy and the rest of her family.
