They were married later in 1962 and then moved to San Antonio in 1963. Dorothy made a career of raising and caring for her children. When they were grown she worked with Randy, was politically active President of Alamo Republican Women's Club, and for 18 years was involved in Bible Study Fellowship BSF. The last 10 years in BSF she served as a discussion leader and volunteered to cook in the BSF kitchen. Dorothy was a believer and was always active in her Church. Most recently Dorothy and Randy were members of Christ Presbyterian Church in New Braunfels. Dorothy faced her final trial with great courage and with the peace that passed all understanding. She has been and will be an inspiration to her family forever.
