



Dorothy "Dottie" Mae Fountain

September 23, 1925 - July 10, 2018

Dorothy "Dottie" Mae Fountain, age 92, passed away the evening of July 10, 2018 in San Antonio, Texas. She was born September 23, 1925 to William and Dora McCall and grew up in Flatonia, Texas where she graduated from High School. Afterwards she moved to San Antonio where she attended San Antonio Business College and started her family.

Dottie was an active member of the Blue Bird Auxiliary at Main Methodist Hospital for 32 years, devoting more than 95,000 hours – the most in the history of the organization. She is a past President of the Blue Birds Auxiliary and served on the sewing committee for 30 years. Dottie volunteered faithfully at the information desk, surgery waiting room, patient escort and assisted with mail and flowers. She was even the first volunteer recipient of the Grace Ann Durr Humanitarian Award. Additionally, she served on numerous committees for the TAHV TX Association of Healthcare Volunteers for 30 years. She was very active in PTA organizations in the Northside School District as an honorary life member of the National Congress of Parents and Teachers and worked with Easter Seals and St. Luke's Catholic Church.

She is preceded in death by her husband Lewis Fountain and sister Patricia Yates. She is survived by sister Mildred Jenkins; children Nancy Casillo (John), Bob Fountain, Peggy Fountain (Rene), Becky Woods (Kevin); grandchildren Eric Bierschenk, Abigail Casillo, Chris Casillo, Chris Coley,

Megan Moody, Joey Moody, Kayla Steward, and Ryan Steward; great grandchildren Julien, Logan, and Aden as well as numerous other family members and a lifetime of friends.

Visitation will be held Sunday, July 15, 2018 at Mission Park North from 5:00 to 8:00 PM with Rosary beginning at 7:00 PM. A funeral mass will be celebrated Monday, July 16, 2018 at St. Luke's Catholic Church beginning at 10:00 AM and interment will follow in Mission Burial Park North.
