Dorothy Lourinda Clark Janacek, 83, daughter of Jack Houston Clark and Adaline Faust Clark, born April 9th, 1927 in Caldwell, TX, passed away January 18th, 2011 at St. Luke's Baptist Hospital in San Antonio, TX.
