Dorothy Ann Kuhn was born on October 8, 1926, and was called home to our heavenly Father on June 19, 1918, at age 91. She was preceded in death by her parents, John and Irene Kuhn, her sister, Mary Barbara Wiesman, and brother, Edward Joseph Kuhn. She is survived by her sister Therese Russell and husband Clarence A. Russell, Jr., her sister Jeannette Walker, 7 nieces, 8 nephews, and many great- and great-great-nieces and nephews.

Dorothy Ann was born in San Benito, Texas, to John Charles Kuhn and Irene Ludmilla Foelker Kuhn of Lozano, Texas. Her parents were farmers. She had several nicknames by an early age, and was fondly called "Dot," "Dottie," and "Mama Dot" throughout her life. Dot attended primary school in Rio Hondo, Texas, then went to San Antonio, Texas, and attended high school at St. Mary's Parochial School. She began her college career at Brownsville Junior College in Brownsville, Texas, and earned her bachelor's degree in Dietetics from Our Lady of the Lake University in San Antonio, Texas. She interned in dietetics in Cincinnati, Ohio, and her first employment as a dietitian was in Houston, Texas.

In 1957, Dot began employment at Baptist Memorial Hospital in San Antonio, Texas, where she was Head Dietitian for many years. She retired after 28 years of service. Soon after retiring, she was busy helping family and friends, including 13 years spent in Houston, Texas, caring for her brother and his wife until their respective deaths.

Dot was loved by all. She was intelligent, creative, kind, generous, and fun-

loving. She loved to read, cook, sew, do needlework, garden, and bird-watch. She had a passion for African Violets and hot tea. Dottie spent the last 12+ years of her life finally in retirement, living with her niece, Terri Anne, and her husband, Bill, splitting time between Austin, Texas, and their ranch in Lockhart, Texas. She loved being at the ranch and spent her last days there.
