



## Dorothy McClellan

April 18, 1918 - February 19, 2007

Dorothy Gulledge McClellan died February 19, 2007 at the age of 87. She was a graduate of East Texas State University. Soon after graduation she began her career in Civil Service working in the Comptroller's office. When she retired after 27-1/2 years of service she was assistant budget officer at Fort Sam Houston. After retirement she became an active volunteer in the Republican Party, serving in various positions in campaigns and elections. In 1980, she was headquarters chairman for the Reagan Campaign and in 1984, she was a state delegate at large to the Republican National Convention in Dallas. She was elected executive secretary of the Bexar County Republican Party for 10 years. Dorothy was a charter member of Churchill Baptist Church, a member of Delta Rho Delta National Sorority and a previous member of several Republican Women's Clubs. She is survived by her 2 sons, Chris and Michael McClellan; brother & sister-in-law, M.C. and Betty Gulledge of Midland; brother-in-law Dr. W.J. Bray of Abilene and numerous nieces and nephews.
