



## Dorothy Lee Shipp

January 22, 1922 - August 11, 2010

Dorothy Lee Shipp, a woman of God, passed in peace on August 11, 2010 at the age of eighty-eight. As a child of God, she has returned home for a joyful heavenly reunion with the Heavenly Father, Jesus Christ her Savior, the Holy Spirit, and family and friends that have gone before.
