Douglas Wayne Gregory of Blanco, Texas, was born on January 1, 1952, in San Antonio, Texas. He went to be with the Lord on December 5, 2018, at his home near Blanco, Texas.

Doug is survived by his wife of 47 years Joyce Elaine Pittman Gregory; his three children Daniel Wayne Gregory (Chris Meier) of Dallas, Texas, Katie Diane Gregory (Chris Kittrell) of Falls Church, Virginia, and Kyle Douglas Gregory (Ruby) of Salt Lake City, Utah; his parents Gene and Jody Gregory of Blanco, Texas; his father Mickey Dellerman of Boerne, Texas; his sisters Sharon Joyce Dellerman Palowski (Frank) of Boerne, Texas, and Susan Louise Gregory Montesi of Leander, Texas; his Aunt Kathy and Uncle Charley Sawers of Floresville, Texas; and numerous cousins, nieces, and nephews.

Doug was a 1969 graduate of McCollum High School in San Antonio and then attended Texas A&I University in Kingsville, Texas, and the University of

Houston. During his college days, Doug DJ'd for the A&I radio station and held positions at other stations after college. He worked his way into the air conditioning and refrigeration business, following in the footsteps of his dad Gene. He owned his own HVAC company for over three decades, having sold it in early 2018.

In early August, Doug became ill and was diagnosed with glioblastoma. He had surgery to remove the tumors, but they reappeared quickly and were quite aggressive. He entered hospice care on September 21 and was cared for at home by his loving wife and children until the time of his passing.

Doug's children were blessed to have such a good man as an example of how to live their lives and how to treat others. His employees and customers knew him to be a man of fairness, honesty, and integrity because his ethics in business were impeccable. The evidence of his and Joyce's parenting shows in the successes their children have all become. His sisters were so fortunate to have him for a brother and have many fond memories of growing up with him and will miss the friends they all became as adults. He never refused help to anyone needing it. Doug was also a caregiver to his parents; and they were all blessed by his love and tenderness toward them, especially in their later years.
