Dr. Barton Ulmer, our beloved husband, father and grandfather passed into the loving arms of our Lord on Saturday, October 24 after suffering a heart attack in Junction, Texas. Dr. Ulmer was born July 17, 1939 in San Antonio, Texas. He is preceded in death by his father Lucien Ulmer. He is survived by his wife Pat of 43 years, daughter Sally McDonald and husband Steve, daughter Susie Smith and husband Jeff and four beautiful grandchildren Jenna, Zack, Ryan and Samantha. He is also survived by his mother Marcelle Ulmer of San Antonio and sister Gaye Tullos of Houston and extended family. Bart practiced dentistry in San Antonio for 42 years and retired in December, 2007. Bart loved his family and patients, and upon retiring spent much of his time enjoying the hill country. Dr. Ulmer will be remembered by his friends and patients as a gentle, caring compassionate man and will be greatly missed by all.

A 3:00 P.M., Memorial Service will be celebrated on Thursday, October 29, 2009 at Mission Park Funeral Chapels North.
