



## Dr. Bynum M Works, Jr. MD

November 9, 1928 - March 29, 2006

Dr. Bynum M. “Mac” Works, Jr., MD, was born November 1928 in Brownsville, Texas to Bynum M. Works and Annalee Konzack Works. Dr. Works was a graduate of University of Texas at Austin in 1948 with his BFA, received his MD degree from the University of Texas Medical School in 1958, and received his Radiology degree from South Texas Medical Center in 1969. He was also a veteran, having served in the U.S. Navy Air Corps. Dr. Works was a member of Phi Kappa Psi, American Academy of General Practice, Bexar County Medical Society, Texas Medical Association, American Medical Association, Radiological Society of North America, American College of Radiology, Texas Radiological Society and the Oak Hills Country Club. He was preceded in death by his mother and father, a brother, Lee Works; sister, Ann Works, and his eldest son, Gordon Douglas Works. Survivors include his wife, Claudia Glover Coleman Works, daughter, Mary Kelly Works, sons: Scott Coleman Works and wife Shelly, and Christopher Alan Works and wife Lori; grandsons: Coleman Alexander Works and Forrest Tyler Works; and sister-in-law, Lillian Works and her children, Laurie, Leighton and Lindsay Works.\*
