Carl Joseph Pauerstein, born May 31, 1932, in New York City, died on November 21, 2005. Dr. Pauerstein was preceded in death by his parents, Carolyn and Philip Pauerstein, and a sister, Minna. Survivors include his wife of 51 years, Marie Louise Pauerstein; sons: Jonathan Pauerstein and wife Valerie, Michael Pauerstein, and Joshua Pauerstein; one sister, Leah Margolis and husband Bill; and three grandchildren: Philip, Ben, and Rachel Pauerstein.

He was an internationally renowned clinician-scientist. As Chairman of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at the University of Texas Health Science Center, he trained generations of physicians.
