Dr. Clement A. Jilek, born in Moulton, TX on November 17, 1922, and went to be with the Lord on November 3, 2010. Dr. Jilek served in the U.S. Marine Corps in WWII with duty throughout the Pacific Theatre and North China. Dr. Jilek served as director and president of the Boys Club of San Antonio, Golden Gloves Chairman, National Area Council Representative, Boys Club of America, President of Anglers Club of San Antonio and arbitrator for Better Business Bureau of San Antonio. As a member of the Southwest Football Officials Assn., Dr. Jilek officiated football for 38 years. He also served as Team Doctor for the U.S. Power Lifting Team and frequently traveled with them for competition in the Soviet Union, China and Spain. He is preceded in death by his daughter, Karol "Kay" Jilek and son, Mark Jilek.
