Dr. Henry M. Sendaula, 69, of Helotes TX, died on January 19, 2016 of complications from early-onset Alzheimer's disease. Henry was born in Kampala, Uganda and died peacefully, surrounded by loved ones. After obtaining an undergraduate, Master's and PhD in electrical engineering from the University of Connecticut he began his teaching and research. He retired from Temple University in 2009, where he had served as professor of electrical engineering since 1986.

His parents, the late Dr. Latimore Musoke and the late Mary Kaate, instilled these values, which Henry passed onto his own children.
