Dr. Michael Lee Peine, 67, of Boerne passed away on October 2, 2014, following a five-month battle with cancer. Lee High School, he went on to receive his bachelor's degree from the University of Texas at Austin and his Doctor of Chiropractic from Texas Chiropractic College in Pasadena, TX.
