Dr. Paul "Pudge" Howard passed away January 3, 2008 at the age of 68. Dr. Howard was a 1957 graduate of Brackenridge High School where he played football and served as Senior Class President. After graduation he attended the University of Texas in Austin where he was a member of Phi Kappa Alpha Fraternity and graduated in 1962. Dr. Howard graduated from Kansas City Osteopathic School of Medicine in 1966. Dr. Howard was in private practice in San Antonio until 1984 and he was well loved by his patients. Dr. Howard practiced medicine in the civilian clinic at Kelly Air Force Base from 1984-1992. His favorite time in life was when he practiced at Ella Austin Health Care Center from 1992 - 2000. He was very proud to serve as team doctor at James Madison High School where he offered free physicals to all of athletes. He also coached CYO and YMCA baseball. In 2000 he left his practice due to illness and he fought a long and valiant fight through many illnesses and surgeries. He was preceded in death by his father C.P. Howard and his sister, LaVerne Semlinger. He is survived by his wife of 44 years Connie Howard; his mother, Evelyn Howard; daughter, Dana Howard; son, Brian Howard and wife Dennie; granddaughter, Kaylor Gayle Howard; and his precious dogs, Beau, Twinkle, Sugar, and Holly.

He will be missed by all his family and friends.
