



Dr. Wallace Anthony Vincent Hedges

August 29, 1923 - May 3, 2011

Dr. Wallace A. V. Hedges, born August 29, 1923 in Faribault, Minnesota, passed away May 3, 2011 at the age of 88. He was preceded in death by his parents Chester C. Hedges and Beatrice R. Hayes Hedges. Dr. Hedges is survived by his cousins Alan and Roger Hedges of San Antonio, Texas, Jeanie Brick of Owatonna, Minnesota, and his good friend James Lay of San Antonio, Texas. Dr. Hedges received his Doctor of Philosophy Degree from the University of New Mexico on December 18, 1976 and had degrees from several other universities. He was a Social for Christis Santa Rosa and taught at the University of the Incarnate Word. He served in the United State Army during WW II. He was a member of the St. Joseph Society and the San Antonio Conservation Society. Later he retired as Executive Director of the Madonna Center. Dr. Hedges received numerous awards for his humanitarian work and he was on the board of Directors for the Healy Murphy Center. Wallace will be sincerely missed by all who knew him. He was a wonderful person who gave of himself unselfishly to those in need. Dr. Wallace Anthony Vincent Hedges was a Christian in every sense of the word.
