Dyane was an active member of Macedonia Missionary Baptist Church, where she participated in and chaired various groups, including Sunday School, The Counting Team, the Tribe of Ephraim, Silver Saints, AA, and Overcomers. Through these ministries, she dedicated herself to helping many of God's Children overcome their addictions- a cause especially close to her heart, as she proudly celebrated over 40 years of sobriety. In recognition of her faith and dedication, she was honored as the Christian Woman of the Year in 1997. A passionate traveler she explored the world with the Silver Saints and with her Bible study groups, Serendipity and the Forget Me Nots. One of her most memorable journeys was a pilgrimage to the Holy Land, Jerusalem, in 2009.

In Dyane's later years, she was a devoted and loving grandmother, wholeheartedly supporting her grandchildren and great-grandchildren in all of their academic achievements and extracurricular activities. Through her strong faith in God, she provided comfort and guidance, she was and always will be their biggest cheerleader. To say she was proud of them would be an understatement - they were the greatest joys of her life. Next to her relationship with Jesus, her family was the most important part of her life. Though she moved away from her home in Arkansas at a young age she remained deeply connected to her extended family.
