Earl W. Duck went home to be with the Lord on May 1, 2019. He was born on July 1, 1930 in Liverpool, NY. He served in the Army during the Korean War, graduated from Syracuse University at Utica with a Bachelors degree in mathematics, and then went on to work in Civil Service for the United States Air Force for 30 years.

He is survived by his wife Diane, sons Earl (Lynda) and Tom, and grandchildren Jon, Brian, and Lindsay, and his great-grandson, Caleb.

Earl came to a saving faith in Jesus Christ late in his life at the age of 55. He then became a faithful and loyal member of Castle Hills First Baptist Church where he served as a Deacon and also on the staff as a hospital minister during the 80's and 90's.

His favorite Bible verse was Romans 10:9 which says "that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved," (NKJV). He liked this verse because it reflected the simplicity of the Gospel in that salvation is by grace alone, through faith alone, in Christ alone. He shared his faith and the simplicity of the Gospel with everyone he could during his life, and would want to do the same at his death by telling everyone that the finish work of Jesus' death on the cross paid everyone's sin debt in full if you simply receive that free gift of grace for

yourself by faith.
