



## Earl Webb Mayfield

August 30, 1927 - November 19, 2016

Earl Webb Mayfield, 89, passed away November 19, 2016. Born August 30, 1927 in Austin, Texas to William Tarlton & Mabel Vaughn Mayfield. He joined the US Marine Corp June 1945 at 17, was discharged in August 1946. Returned to Austin High School, graduated in June 1948. Married Doris Dickey, March 17, 1949 & had two daughters. Earl spent 4 ½ years in the Austin Fire Dept. as Chief Civilian Fire Inspector at Bergstrom Air Force Base. Moved his family to San Antonio in 1960, worked for Frontier Enterprises for many years & later Bill Miller's. Bought G/M Steak House in 1971, operated until he sold in 1993. During that time he purchased the property on FM 2252 in 1982, cleared the trees & built Kitty Hawk Flying Field. Owner/operator until he died. Married Sally Meyer in 1994. Earl was a lifetime Mason & active member of TRA for 35 years & was inducted into Hall of Fame in 1991.

He was preceded in death by his parents, brothers WT Mayfield & G. Vaughn Mayfield, of Austin, wife Sally Mayfield & his daughters mother Doris Mayfield. Survived by daughters Vicki Carlson (Rick Carlson) Joni Falcone (Paul Falcone) grandchildren Terri Harrison, Samuel Falcone & many nieces, nephews.

Earl had a good life & loved to help other people in any way that he could. He will be greatly missed by his family, friends & everyone at the Flying Field.

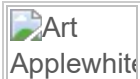
