He retired as a GS14 Supervisor of Procurement U.S. Small Business Administration Office of Government Contracting, and again as an Associate Professor Emeritus at Our Lady of the Lake University.

Edgar supported St. Matthew Catholic Church through his time and donations, volunteering as a Eucharistic Minister, and Usher. He also held various offices in supporting roles as a Scout Master of the Boy Scouts of America and served on the Board of Directors for San Antonio Federal Credit Union. Edgar was active in his grandchildren's lives and was an avid Spurs fan and season ticket holder for 28 years. He loved to travel, taking various cruises throughout different parts of the world.
