Edith Anne Koch Conrad peacefully passed into Eternal Life on March 27 in Richardson, Texas. She was born in San Antonio, Texas on December 8, 1921, to Ida and Rudolph Koch. The youngest of three siblings, she grew up in Harlandale where she lived for 85 years

Edith was a sweet, dear, and loving mother, grandmother, aunt and friend. Following graduation from Blessed Sacrament Academy in 1938, she attended Incarnate Word College and then went to work at Kelly AFB as a typist. Soon thereafter she married the love of her life, Arvin, whose career as a flight instructor found the couple and firstborn son living in Uvalde, Texas. At the end of the war the Conrad family returned to the family properties on Barrett Avenue surrounded by the Hillje and Koch families. The Conrad home and shaded backyard was the setting for countless parties and dinners with family and friends. Edith was an excellent cook, nimble-fingered pianist, seamstress, and tireless volunteer and supporter of her children's schools: Blessed Sacrament Academy, San Jose Mission School, La Salle High School, Providence High School and St. Mary's University. She was preceded in death by her loving husband Arvin, and brothers Rudolph and Ferdinand Koch. Edith is survived by her sister, Frances Hillje; children Arvin Conrad and wife Olive, John Conrad and wife, Sally; Elizabeth Goedecke and husband,

Mark; her precious grandsons Christopher and Jeff Conrad; Thomas and Jonathan Goedecke; and numerous nieces and nephews.
