



Edmund O. Martinez

Edmund Ed Martinez, retired USAF Master Sergeant, was born in San Antonio to Carmen and Isidoro Martinez. He graduated from Fox Tech High School in 1947.

Beginning as a caddy in his teens, playing golf was Ed's lifelong passion.

Ed joined the Marine Corps in 1948 and transferred to the USAF in 1956, and he was stationed at Randolph AFB.

In 1962 Ed and his family moved near Melbourne Australia, where he played golf and served with the 57th Weather Reconnaissance Squadron.

The family returned to the United States in 1965, and he flew around the world as a C-130 flight engineer before he retired in 1968.

The family then settled in San Antonio where he later established Sunrise Industries, which he retired from in 2008.

He is survived by his wife Molly, his sons Edmund and Eric, his daughter Lissa, her husband Brian, their sons Richard and Neil Hughes, and his sister Bertha Garza. He was preceded in death by his brothers Miguel and I.O. Martinez.
