Edwadyne (Eddie) N. (Gerdes) Miller joined her Lord on November 18, 2022 at her residence in Seguin, Texas. She was born on October 15, 1930 in San Antonio, to Edwin Gerdes and Natalie Zwicke Gerdes. Mrs. Miller was preceded in death by her beloved husband, Eugene Miller; and her brother, Darwin Gerdes. She is survived by her daughter, Wanda Miller; sons, Johnny Miller and Jody Miller (Margo); sister, Sharon Doege (Clifton); nieces, Pam, Rafaye and Marcie; and nephews, Ronnie, Jeff and Aaron.

Eddie was Born on October 15, 1930, in San Antonio, Texas at 305 Stace Street. She went to Hillcrest Elementary School, Harris Jr. High then Luther Burbank High School where she graduated early in 1947 at the age of 16.

She worked a few years at Fox Photographic Company downtown on Broadway and experienced the coldest ever recorded day in San Antonio of Zero degrees on January 31, 1949. She Married Eugene Miller on March 26th, 1949, and moved to Muskegon Michigan where they lived for 13 months and worked at Manning, Maxwell & Moore Continental Motors. They moved back to San Antonio in 1951 at the request of her mother where she worked at USAA. They bought their first and last home at 214 Saxon in 1953 for \$10,000. As a stay-at-home Mom, she raised three children: Wanda, Johnny, and Jody.

Her husband, Gene, passed away in 1977 leaving her to raise Johnny and Jody alone. She did an amazing job and quickly had to learn to drive. To raise a little extra money and help pass the time, she worked on and off for We Care Products, a mail-order button company from 1992 to 1993 She also worked as an election judge 1995-2001.

As if she didn't have enough to do, she volunteered at school and church.

Her hobbies included Genealogy, Family Historian, and Scrap-booking.

She often went on guided tours and visited many places including California, Washington DC., Hawaii, Alaska, Germany, and The Virgin Islands. Bus tours included most of Texas and various other states. There aren't many places in Texas she hadn't seen.

Overall, she lived a very good life. She experienced the American Dream and so much more. There has never been a better mother than Eddie Miller. She will be remembered fondly by everyone who knew her.
