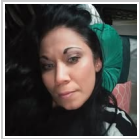

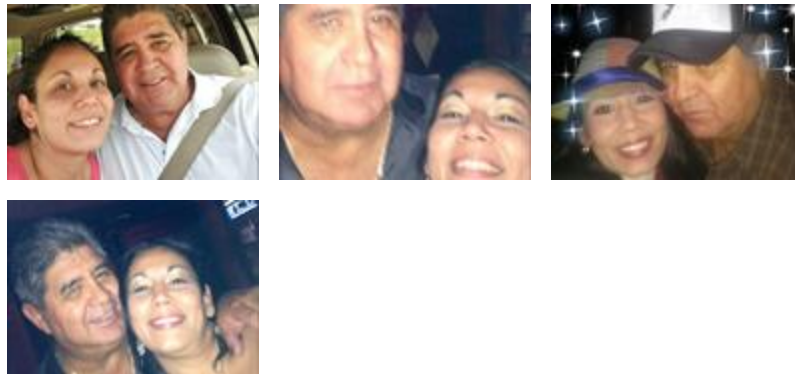

“ Dear Garza Family, I wanted to share some work memories with you especially for Ed's grandchildren that I'm sure Ed kept close hold for he was a very humble person and never wanted a pat on the back. I worked with Ed while at Kelly AFB in the same office for 11 years. Boy did he teach and set me straight on how to interact with mechanics and gain their shop floor knowledge. He worked as my Industrial Planner Lead on the B-1B program. We traveled together in support of bringing this workload to Kelly AFB. Of course, he knew how to overcome the technical challenges and obstacles. I listened to every wise word he would share, not much of a talker but a true doer and when he talked lots of people listened including me. He was my travel partner to many aerospace plants and B-1B Air Force bases. We made several trips together to Phoenix, AZ (Allied Signal Aerospace), Utica, NY (Lucas Aerospace), Montgomeryville, PA (Chant Engineering), and Rapid City, North Dakota (Ellsworth AFB). A short story while we were at Ellsworth.....there were a few B-1Bs that could not start their engines and the maintenance crews there could not figure out the problem, so the AF flew Ed and I there to help start the engines. We solved the problem and were able to start the engines. In return, they allowed Ed and I to go inside a B-1B aircraft pilot cockpit. While they were running up the engines full throttle for a flight check on the ground. How we got inside the cockpit and what we saw inside the cockpit cannot be told, but only seen with our own eyes. I really enjoyed working with Ed, he was always cool and calm in tight situations. While on the way to Ellsworth in the rental car and passing the Blackhill mountains we saw a B-1B aircraft make a flight maneuver only our eyes will ever know. We were in awe and could not believe our eyes what we just saw. I will keep this memory for Ed and I. I also enjoyed going to Ed's bar and having great conversations with my dear friend, he made me laugh with his jokes. I will miss him. My family and I are carrying the burden of your pain and grief. Remember Ed as he was and the good times you shared with him. Always talk about him to each other. He is now with his Lord.
