Edward G. “Wayo” Gutierrez, entered into rest and is with the Lord on this day, Saturday, May 21, 2005, at the age of 72. He was born on October 5, 1932 in San Antonio, Texas. Wayo attended Harlandale H.S. and then joined the U.S. Air Force in 1951. Upon his return to San Antonio in 1955, he met Leonor Torres at Karam’s Restaurant and married her in 1957, the same year he earned his Associate’s Degree from St. Phillips College in Industrial Education. He retired from civil service work in 1979 as a Small Arms Repairer. Although retired, his passion to repair arms continued the rest of his life. He also co-owned Mission Trail Grocery with Leonor until 2000. Wayo was the caretaker for the Mission Espada Cemetery and a fundraiser for many local/civic activities.
