Edward Roy Kesl, Sr. died peacefully at 103 years of age on November 10. He was born on April 30, 1917 in St. Louis, Missouri and raised by his adoptive parents, Capt. Roy William Kesl, USA of St. Louis, Missouri and Sofia Hernández Arrieta of Durango, Mexico. Roy grew up in Sutherland Springs Texas, Mexico City, and Gómez Palacio Durango. He proudly served in the U.S. Army during World War II, stationed in both the Pacific and European Theaters. In 1948, Roy married Marina Amescua Pámanes moving to San Antonio where they lived until her passing on August 10, 1987. During his career, Roy—also known as Eddie—worked at Steves Lumber Company and Friedrich Airconditioning and Refrigeration. He was an active member of St. Stephen's Catholic Church, loving his role as coach of the girls softball team and serving as presidents of the Parish Council, Men's Club, and the parish CYO. Roy is survived by his 5 children, 4 grandchildren, and 4 great grandchildren. His children are Theresa, Robert, Charles (wife, Angie and daughter, Alina), Edward Roy, Jr. (wife, Kathy; children John, wife Gloria; and Jennifer, husband Steve Noriega), and Billy (partner, Denise Saari and his children, Garrett, and Katie of fond memory). A funeral Mass will take place at St. Dominic's Catholic Church on Thursday, November 19th at 12:30 p.m.,

immediately followed by burial at Ft. Sam Houston National Cemetery. All are welcomed.
