Edward E. Lewis, age 85, entered the gates of heaven to be with the Lord peacefully on October 31st, 2019, surrounded by family and loved ones. He was born January 21st, 1934 in Laredo, Texas to Edward E. Lewis Sr. and Lucy L. Lewis. At the age of 17 he enlisted in the U.S. Army and attended Infantry and Jump School at Fort Benning, Georgia. A member of the 82nd Airborne Division, Company "K" 508th Infantry Regiment, Edward served during the Korean War from 1950 to 1951. After his honorable discharge in 1954, he settled in San Antonio, Texas for the remainder of his life and became a founding and lifelong member of the Alamo Silver Wings Association and served in the Texas State Guard as a First Sergeant under the command of Val Martinez. 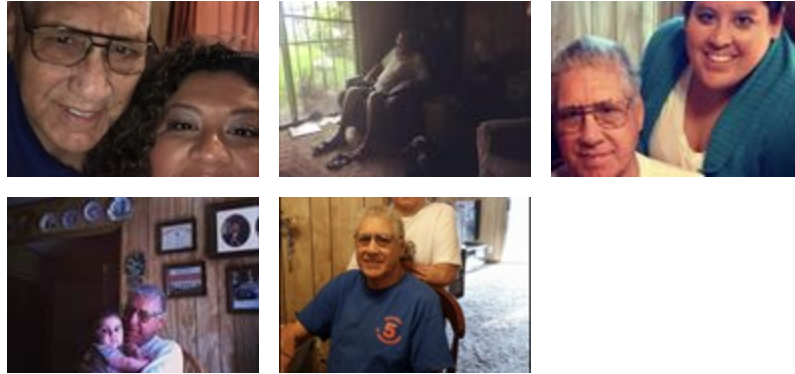

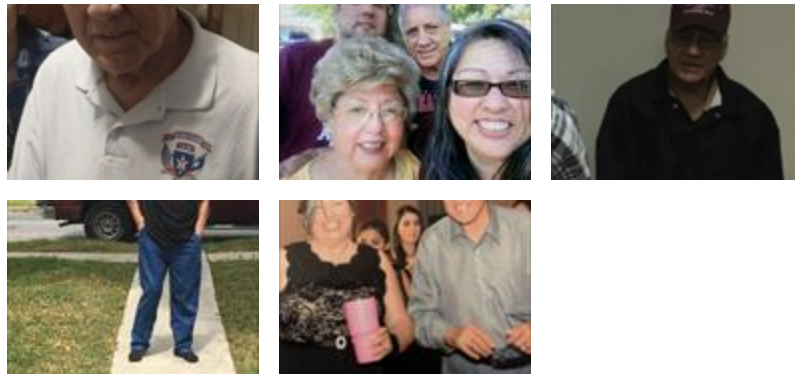
