



Dr. Edward R. Staffel

Dr. Edward R. Staffel, DDS, born July 4, 1935 in San Antonio, TX, passed away suddenly on Sunday, November 18, 2018. He was a graduate of Baylor University where he earned his Doctor of Dental Surgery degree. Opening and developing a successful dental practice that spanned nearly sixty years, Dr. Staffel provided compassionate care to his patients and pioneered cutting edge techniques in restorative dentistry and co-developed alternative sedation procedures. Dr. Staffel was considered by his peers to be one of the most outstanding restorative dentists in the country. He considered his patients and office team extended family and nurtured a cohesive practice that he loved. Dr. Staffel's 20- year long dental radio program on KTSA covering 99 TX counties has encouraged and assisted many Texans in maintaining their dental health as it relates to systemic health. Dr. Staffel's associate, Dr. Mark J. Williamson, will carry on the legacy of excellence that his practice has established and the dedication to his dental family. His professional memberships were many. He strongly supported the San Antonio Symphony where he was a longtime patron and underwriter. Spending time in the out of doors comprised Dr. Staffel's recreational interests, but fishing and hunting were his passions. Preceded in death by his wife, Doris Geyer Schorlemer-Staffel. Dr. Staffel is survived by his children, Ross Staffel and his wife Tana, Dr. Scott Staffel, Joe Staffel, Janis Ploetz and husband Jim, and Beth Schorlemer; long time dear friend and companion, Carolyn B. Sanders; precious grandchildren include Mixson, Sarah, Ben, Julia, and Edward Staffel

III; Jordan and Jett Ploetz; brother, Ferd Staffel; sister, Patricia Staffel Carter; numerous nieces and nephews; and many dear friends.
