Edwin M. Barton was born in Dallas GA on June 5, 1917 and went home to be with the Lord on October 23, 2008. He was a graduate of Duke University, '43 and Yale Divinity School, '45. He was a chaplain in the U.S. Navy and served in China and during the Korean War. Most of his career was as Student Activities Director at Columbia College of Physicians and Surgeons in New York City. On retiring he was pastor of Methodist churches in Thiells NY, Flemington NJ and Johnson City TX. Ed is the author of one book "Physicians to the Mayas", and numerous articles for Voice magazine. He is survived by his wife Rae Beth; 4 children, Priscilla, Katherine Jerry, Mary, and Paul Kim. Also survived by 7 grandchildren, Jessica Scott, Paloma, Jian, Samuel, Nathan, Josiah, and Isaac. A Memorial Service will be held at Wayside Chapel, 1705 NW Loop 410 on Sunday, October 26, 2008 at 4:00 PM.
