Elaine Joyce Wolle Breland, age 74, of San Antonio, Texas, passed into the Heavenly Kingdom on April 27, 2010. She was born on May 16, 1935, in San Antonio to the late Vernon and Lillian Miller Wolle. She graduated from Thomas Jefferson High School, San Antonio, in 1953 and married Homer Keller Breland on September 3, 1954. She traveled the next 18 years as an Air Force wife, living in Charleston, SC, Kansas City, MO, Colorado Springs, CO, Ramstein, Germany, and finally returning to San Antonio, TX. During this time, she regularly volunteered with the Red Cross as a dental assistant. Elaine was a life-long Lutheran: baptized, confirmed, and married at Zion Lutheran Church on Cincinnati Ave. in San Antonio, and a member of Hope Lutheran Church in San Antonio. She actively served in many roles in the church: Altar Guild member, Hannah Circle treasurer, Craft Guild member, Lutheran World Relief monitor, Lunch Bunch member, Meals on Wheels team member, and Bereavement Committee chair.
