



Eldred A. Jordan

November 9, 1917 - December 20, 2006

Eldred A. Jordan passed away, December 20, 2006 at the age of 89. Eldred was born on November 9, 1917 in Cain City, Texas. He attended school in Anson, San Antonio, Shive and Hamilton, Texas and graduated from Hamilton in 1935. After one semester at Texas Tech he returned home to help on the family farm. His family moved to Fredericksburg, where Eldred played in a local dance band called the Blue Jays. He enlisted in the Army October 13, 1940, and after basic he was sent to Ft. Belvoir, Virginia. He married Elsie Matson on April 25, 1942. He attended Officers Candidate School and received his commissions and was sent to England in early August, 1942. He went to France shortly after "D-Day" and returned to the USA when the war was over and retired as a Captain. He returned to Texas Tech and received his BS in Agriculture in 1952. He taught at Tech for three years before going to the Agriculture Extension Service. He served as Associate Agent in Gonzales County and then as County Extension Agent in Starr County and Frio County. He retired in 1977 and moved to San Antonio. His wife, Elsie, died in 1980. He married Hattie Hamilton in 1982 and died in 2002. He was a member of Christ Presbyterian Church, The Lion's Field Camera Club, the National Association of Federal Employees and several bowling leagues. He is survived by three brothers, Melvin Jordan and friend, Elida Holt of San Antonio, Bruce F. Jordan and wife, Bernice S., Grayson Jordan and wife Ann all of Fredericksburg; and numerous nieces, nephews and a host of friends.
